# What is E-Waste?

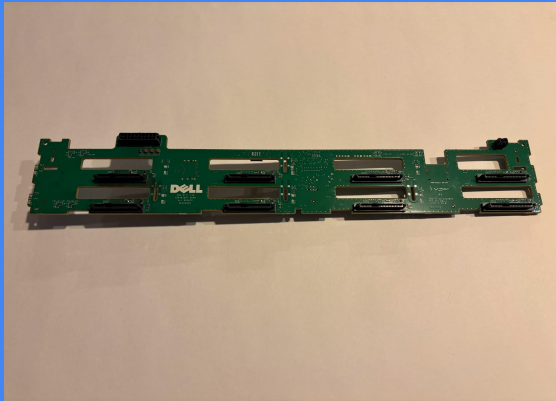
- E-Waste is any unwanted electronics such as: **PCs, monitors, printers, medical equipment, DVD players, electrical cables, etc.**
- The US throws away 8 million tons of E-Waste each year.
- All these things that get thrown into landfills have valuable components that could be recycled.

# What do I do?

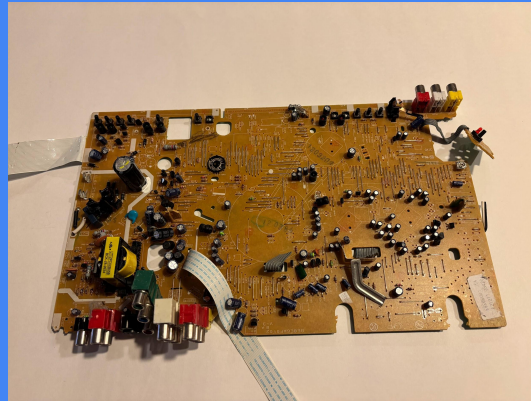
- I pick up almost any unwanted or end of life electronics to recycle them.
- I disassemble or scrap out electronics for valuable metals to sell to Aurum Recovery.

Circuit boards are valued based on the metals that are inside and on them.

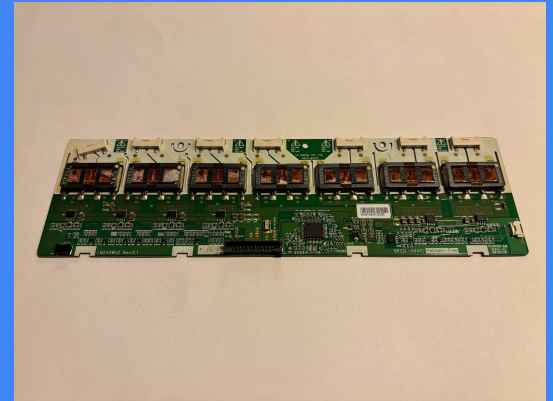
**Mixed boards:  
4 dollars/pound**



**Low grade:  
45 cents/pound**



**Mid grade:  
1.75 dollars a pound**

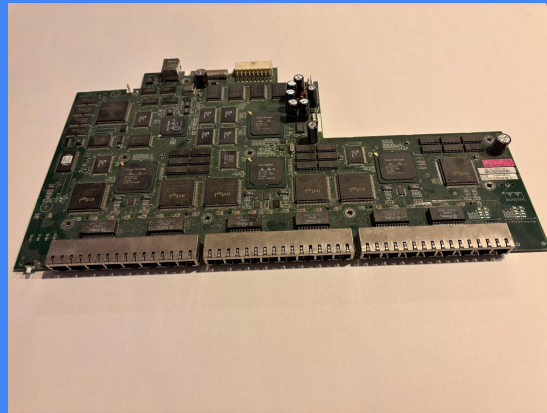


# Other circuit board grades

5.50/pound**

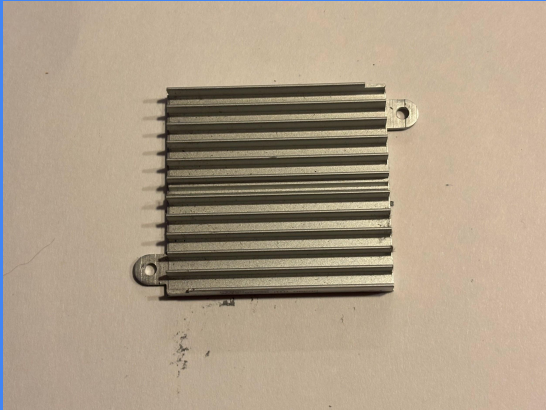


**Gold finger cards:

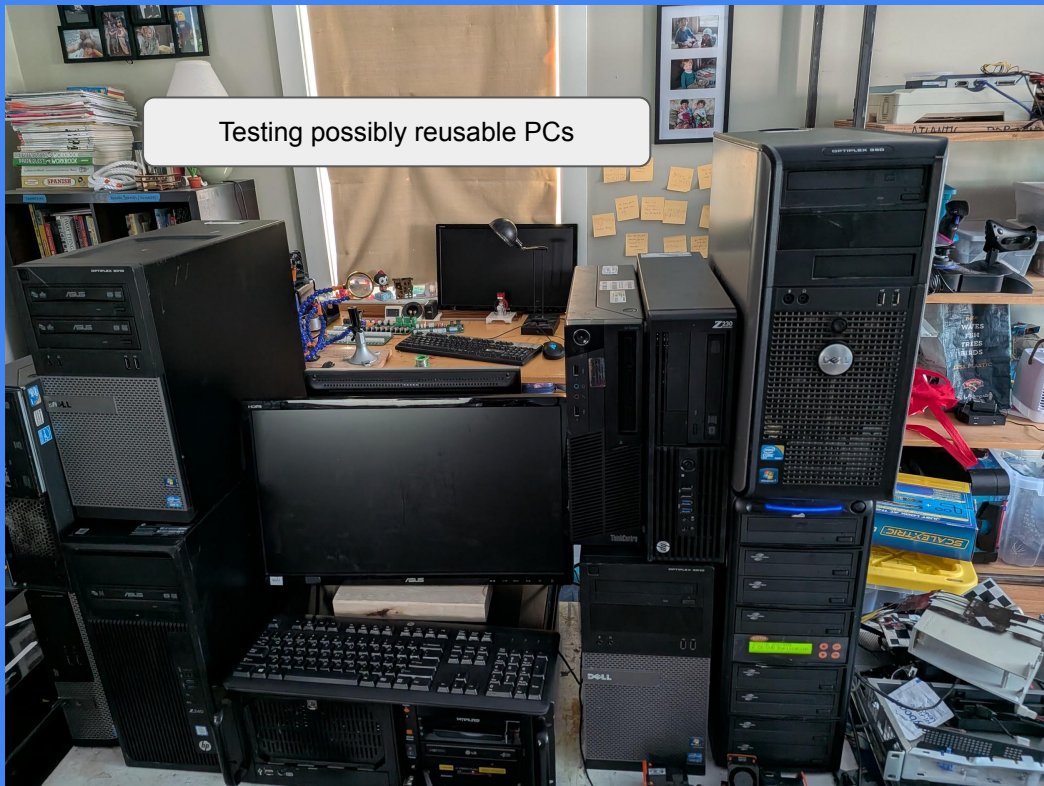

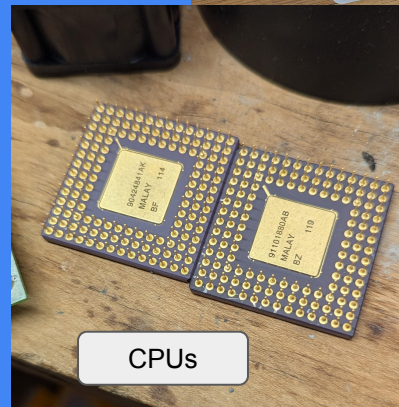

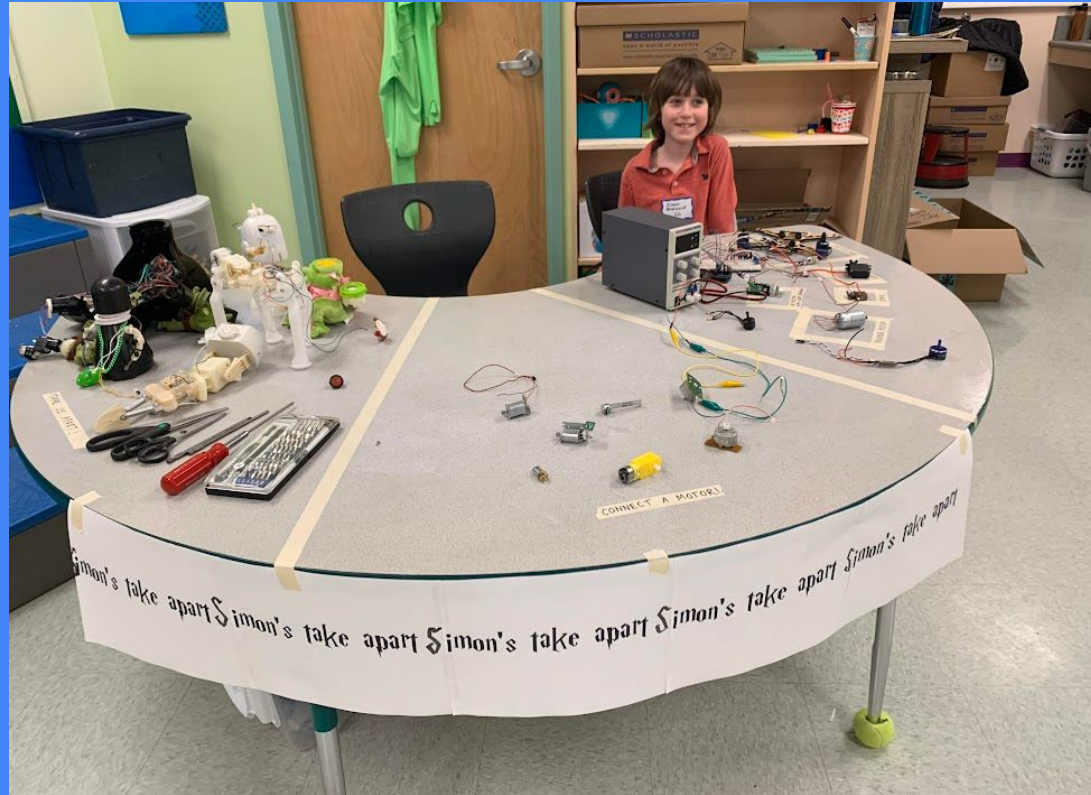
## KEY POINTS

- The current AI boom is only three years old, so estimating depreciation remains a challenge.

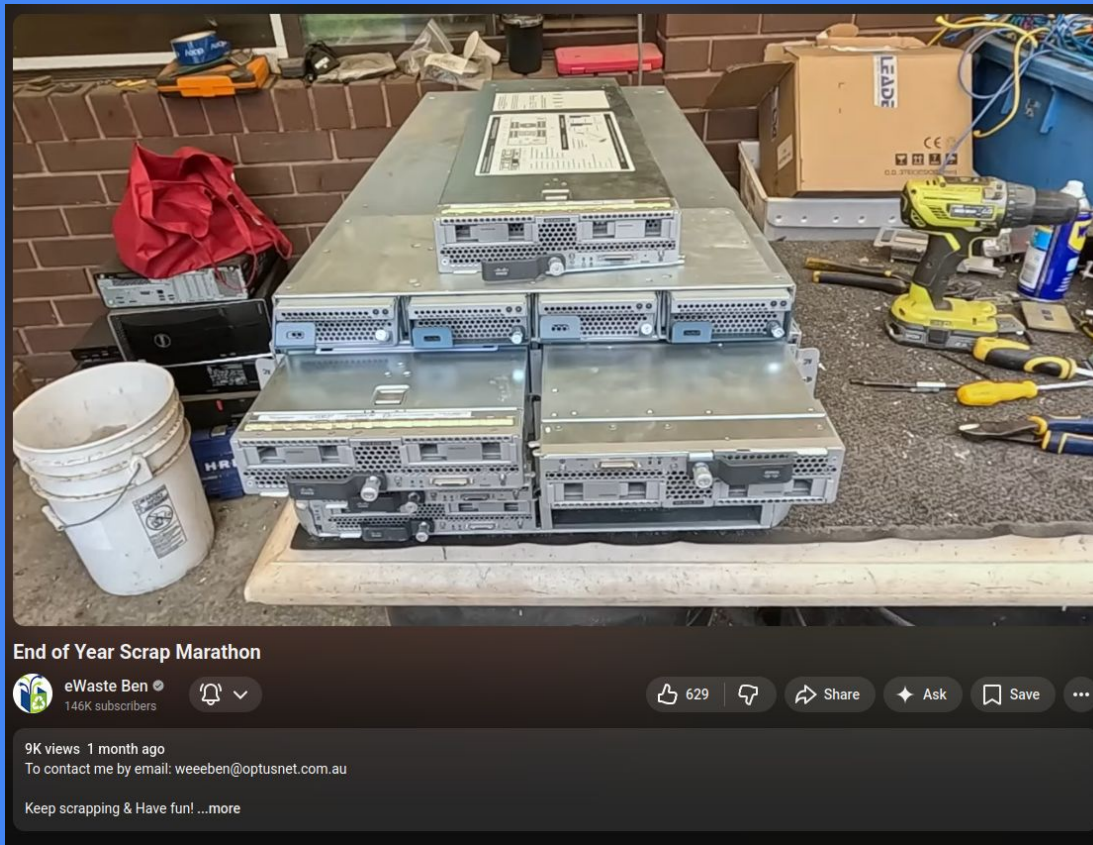

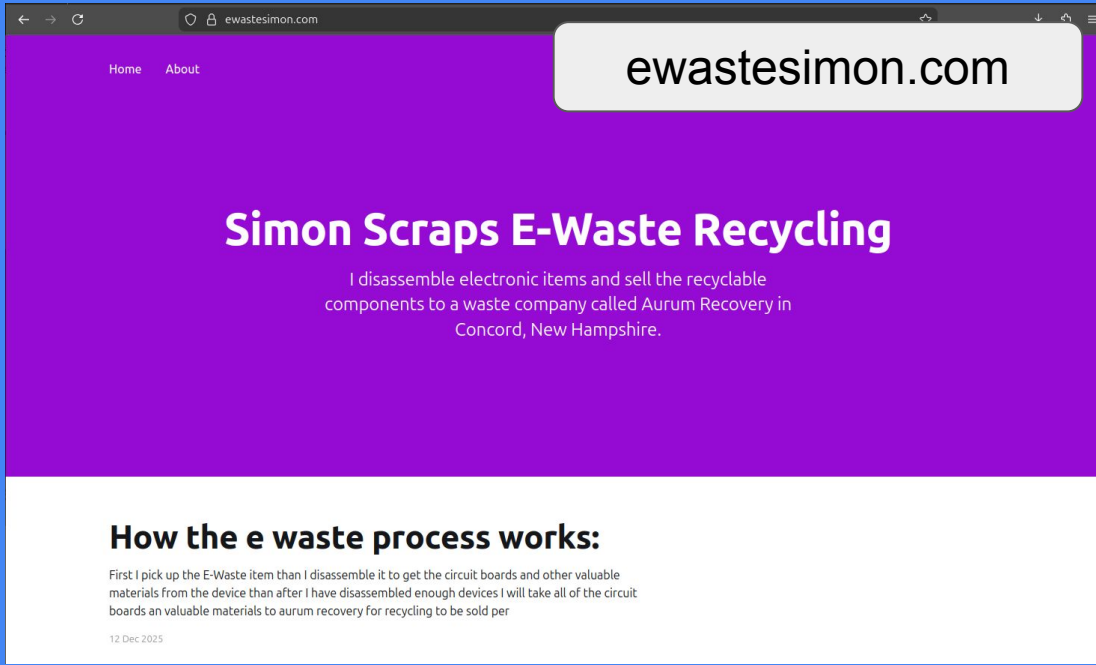
